2017 is a hugely significant and exciting year for The South Bucks Community Hospice. The move into our stunning purpose-built £4.8m building means that we will significantly increase our capacity to deliver care.

Our 15,000 sq ft. three storey building, situated on the former Kingswood School site in Totteridge Lane, High Wycombe, will put all of our charity's services under one roof, and also allow room to expand and evolve in response to need. Our patients, their families and carers are at the heart of everything we do and I know people will very quickly be reaping the benefits of this move, in terms of care and convenience.

Our Lymphoedema Clinic provides highly specialist knowledge in the treatment of all patients with Lymphoedema and other chronic oedemas. For the last fifteen years the team have been based 3 miles from the main Hospice and we are delighted that the new Hospice means that we will all be under one roof. Our new Lymphoedema suite comprises four treatment rooms as well as a support group and exercise class.

Did you know? On average the service that we provide would cost £80ph privately. All of the services we provide are free.
